

VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

The following job descriptions will help you decide where you will best shine as one of our treasured volunteers.

Ticket sales are scheduled in two-hour increments on Saturday and three-hour increments on Sunday.

Other positions are scheduled in three-hour increments.

Set-up and Take-down needs helps for as many hours as you can offer.



Ticket Sales

Greet guests with a welcome smile as they come through the gate, handle ticket sale money, distribute wrist bands. This position can be a standing and/or sitting duty.

Parking

Guide guests to parking spots, work Sheriff's department gate. Mostly standing and some walking. Bring your own chair for slow times.

Tea Tent

Servers, host and hostesses needed as well as food prep and bussing help.

Beer Truck

Serve beer, handle money for beer sales. Standing duty.

Children's Glen

Volunteers needed to help with children's crafts and games. Standing and sitting duty. Must like to work with kids.

Pub Tent

Servers needed to serve food. Standing/walking.

Coke

Coke Sale, handle money. Standing/sitting.

Hot Dog Sales

Take money for hot dog sales. Sitting duty in the sun or you may bring an umbrella.

Set-Up Help

Set up of chairs, tables, tents and other festival items.

Thursday, January 4, 2018 starting at 8:00 a.m.

Vendor Usher

Walkers needed to walk vendors onto the field.

Friday, January 5 - 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Kitchen for Tea Tent

Kitchen help needed to make sandwiches for Tea Tent.

Friday, January 5 starting at 9:00 a.m.

Take-Down Help (evening)

Break down tables, tents and chairs.

Sunday, January 7 starting at the close of the festival at 5 p.m.

Take-Down Help (next morning)

Transfer remaining festival items back to St. Columba and the storage unit in Marathon.

Monday, January 8 starting at 8:00 a.m.
